Avram Hershko, 2004 Nobel Laureate in Chemistry, Member of Israel Academy of Sciences and Humanities, Foreign academician of Chinese Academy of Sciences(CAS), held that basic research is central to all important innovations in the pharmaceutical industry. The remarkable improvement in human health over the past 50 years or so may largely be credited to great innovations in pharmacy, biotechnology and biomedical instrumentation, and major discoveries in the basic biomedical sciences. Yet, in the long run, innovation always relies on advance in basic research. That is, basic research is a long-term social investment in technological innovation. Therefore, to have highly original innovations in the industry, our society should support high-quality basic research.

Zhang Boli, Academician of Chinese Academy of Engineering, Winner of National Honorary Title of "People's Hero" in 2020, shared his insights into the modernization of TCM: first, TCM should adhere to the law of development of TCM in its modernization drive, namely, to respect fundamental principles; second, the modernization of TCM must be integrated with modern technology, namely, to make innovations; and third, the modernization of TCM needs to cultivate high-quality talents, namely, to bolster the support systems. Nowadays, with China being in a well-off society in all respects, the intensifying contradiction between the growing demand and insufficient supply of highquality TCM services has risen over time to be the internal driving force behind the modernization and high-quality development of TCM, while the increased expectation of TCM from international communities and the accelerating foray into TCM by foreign drug R&D forces has provided an external pressure for the modernization and high-quality development of TCM. Under these circumstances, we must implement the strategy of innovation-driven development, lay the solid foundation of "carrying forward the essences of TCM culture, upholding fundamental principles and breaking new ground" and build a new pattern of the modernization and high-quality development of TCM.

Lin Guoqiang, Academician of Chinese Academy of Sciences, Dean of Innovation Research Institute of Traditional Chinese Medicine of Shanghai University of Traditional Chinese Medicine, pointed out that Japanese Kampo Medication accounts for 90% of the global drug market whereas China's TCM is yet to increase its penetration rate, so we should strengthen and promote efficient and organized scientific research in this aspect, especially higher-level research. As for some rare and endangered medicinal herbals, we should not only find out their alternatives but also cultivate them in a big way, improve them and ensure their medicinal quality. At the same time, we should strengthen multidiscipline research on TCM with chemistry, biology, medicine and other sectors to bring out the full efficacy of TMC so as to continuously improve its awareness in the global market.



Leon Wang, Executive Vice President of AstraZeneca Group, said that one of the biggest lessons learned from the ongoing epidemic by AstraZeneca is that the global fight against the disease should go beyond national borders, and in particular, the distribution of vaccines should be more oriented towards low-income countries. China has shown stronger resilience in the global supply chain and has made positive contributions to the world's fight against the epidemic. Yet, from other points of view, there is a lot of room for improvement in China, for example, how to ensure some vulnerable people, such as patients under tumor radiotherapy and chemotherapy and patients with blood diseases, hemodialysis and other urgent medical conditions, receive continued treatment while fighting the epidemic. Therefore, as the situation is ebbing back to normal, making normal treatment available to vulnerable people, protecting them from the impacts of the epidemic, and ensuring the sustainable development of serious and chronic disease management will be the main thrust of concerted efforts for both health departments and pharmaceutical enterprises in all countries.

Greg Holman, President of Stryker China, said that in China, multinationals can find various excellent partners who can help them make their marks in this vast market, which is boosting the confidence of foreign enterprises to make their heavy investments here. Compared with local enterprises, multinationals tend to be slow in their decision-making, so they should further improve their efficiency, and meanwhile, they also should foster good cooperative relationships. In fact, the two efforts are complementing and reinforcing each other.
